General Information

1. All exhibitors are to be signed up 1 class prior to class entered. No refunds without vet certificate.
2. Each competitor and guardian of competitor under age 18 and any agents, spectators, or representatives of the competitors or owners agree to hold Penn Jersey Horse Show Association and Saddle Valley Farm harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with this show whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly from any act or omissions of such officials, agents, or land owners.
3. Lunch break is at the discretion of the judge.
4. Junior riders must wear helmets with attached harnesses and all riders must wear helmets while mounted.
5. All dogs must be leashed and be under control at all times.
6. No junior may handle a Stallion.
7. 6 ribbons per class plus first prize trophy. Champion and reserve champion for each division – Mini-Stirrup, Short Stirrup Equitation, Open Beginner Equitation, Pony Hunter, Green Maiden, Maiden Equitation, Pre-Children’s Hunter, Children’s Hunter Horse, Children’s Equitation 13 and under, Equitation 14-18, Equitation Adult, Pleasure Division, Open Limit.
8. All fence classes in hunter divisions will run back to back. (Riders go in groups of 3, each rides first course, then each rides second course, then next group of 3 goes, etc.)
9. For Hunter championships, only top 4 in Over Fences classes will be eligible.
10. Special Grand Champion High Point and Reserve Grand Champion High Point horse/pony of the day awards (can be any rider on same horse/pony).
11. Great BBQ breakfast and lunch until about 3 PM.
12. Pre-entries must be postmarked by 6/13/05. Make Checks payable to Saddle Valley Farm, 2542 Ackermanville Road, Bangor, PA 18013

Directions:

From South (Allentown, Bethlehem, Easton): Take Route 22 east to Route 611 north to first light in Martins Creek (about 8 miles). Go straight at light through Martins Creek for 2.2 miles. Make first left into farm on Good Road, after you see the white fences (1/4 mile up the road).

From North:

Take route 33 South to Wind Gap/Bangor exit. Left at exit and left onto route 512 North to Bangor. In Bangor make a right onto Route 191 south (at the traffic light). Go about _ mile and make first left after passing Country Carpets (tan building on right). Go over viaduct (bridge) and go one block to light. Make a right at the light (South Main Street). Go about three miles until you see a street on the right with our sign and white fences on either side – Meadow Creek Lane. Go right on meadow creek and left at the stop sign (Ackermanville Road). Saddle valley farm is _ mile up the road on the right.
